My husband and I have found out that several of our local Washington County government boards don't meet basic Indiana

code standards.

Starting with our County Planning and Zoning Board which has 4 illegal citizen members - 3 that don't live within the jurisdiction of the board (as per IC 36-7-4-216) and 1 who changed political parties making too many of the same political party - (IC 36-7-4-208).

We put all of our argument up on https://www.ThatGreeneWoman.com - video clips, documents and links to where we got the information.

We also looked into the City of Salem Planning commission which has at least 2 illegal members appointed by the County Commissioners.

1 that doesn't live within the jurisdiction of the board (as per IC 36-7-4-216) and 1 who changed political party

making it too many from one party - (IC 36-7-4-208). We haven't done as much research with this board, but we know these 2 members do not comply with state law.

The reason that we really looked into Salem was they have passed an ordinance, but not through their zoning board. They are

calling it a common council ordinance. But it appears to be a developmental standard that should have gone through

their planning commission.

We had a lot of Democrats change to Republican this year and so the Property Tax Assessment Board and the Weed Board are both also non compliant.
